Greetings to you!

Greetings to you all and thank you again for all the love, support and prayers. We are continuing to be the hands and feet of the Lord. We continue to prepare for an upcoming outreach all in God's timing. We hope to share some exciting news next month there are some great things in process here in Samoa.

We are being very intentional in the place God has called us. We completed a two week language class at National University of Samoa (NUS). We had a great time learning and still struggle with pronunciation of the language we have a good start. The letters of the alphabet in Samoa are different in sounds than in US. An example is AEIOU – the A sounds like A but AH, but the E is pronounced like an "A" like in Canada "ay". Then the I is the hardest it sounds like an E! The struggle is real but we laugh and continue and keep practicing.

I am growing in what God has called me to do here stepping into some preaching! I shared a word July 8th to a group of young adults at Supernatural Fellowship. God moved and stretched me. I am scheduled to be one of the speakers for Father's Day here August 8th.

We made connection with a local wholesaler here and were so blessed with favor. We purchased 10 case of Maagi noodles and received 2 cases free. We bought 10 cases of "Tin Fish" canned Mackerel. We also purchased some sugar. We have bags of rice also to give. We are helping families that have been affected by no employment related to the State of Emergency.

We have continued to be active with various ministries here in the island. We have a weekly commitment on Tuesdays to minister the children at Samoa Victims Support Group (SVSG) Campus of Hope. We can't share pictures from here none are allowed unless they take them and publish. We are teaching the bible and loving on the children. These children are like foster children in the US. One young girl said to Mindy last week "thank you for coming you make us happy". We bring love and Jesus.

We have ministered in several churches this month and our host church. We minister at the hospital every two weeks on Saturday with Faith Angel Foundation. We are now both active with Manuia the bible study group at local business. I am continuing to study for the exhorter exam.

Mindy was one of the speakers last weekend at the Women of Purpose Conference. It was so successful, and we give God the glory. The unity in the room was powerful. Many, many souls saved, women set free, called into ministry, and set apart. Mindy prayed with 5 women that accepted Jesus as savior! She shared how God used all of the team to minister and again unity with everyone. She made new friends and new connections.

We are also meeting once week with Fortress of Faith a group of ministry friends. We are hoping to go to Savaii the other island here. We had planned to go last week but felt like we needed to wait. The prison ministry is still on hold the door has remained closed for some time now.
