We remain here on the island and the State of Emergency continues. There are now just this last week two confirmed cases of COVID-19 of individuals from repatriation flights. The individuals will remain in quarantine no cases outside so we are at low risk.

We had a great month with Faith Angel Foundation. A young woman we met last year had lost a child to measles, we met her recently in the pediatric ward, her newest child had pneumonia. She recognized us and Mindy prayed against fear the woman was visibly touched. She had fear of the loss of this child .



We continue to minister at Samoa Victims Support Group (SVSG) on a weekly basis every Tuesday morning. We are continuing Armor of God and then starting on Fruits of the Spirit. We also have added a Thursday evening twice a month. We are teaching Thursday morning advocacy classes.

Jim attended a men's conference. Fit Man he really enjoyed it. He met some new friends.
