Samoa is slowly allowing Samoans to return home on repatriation flights. The quarantine period has increased to 21 days. If a person has a known COVID history in last 6 months they are not allowed to return yet.

What a interesting time we live in. The economy here has suffered because tourism is the industry for the island. There are many empty booths in the market, businesses have closed.

If you are wanting to come with a team everyone will have to be COVID free for 6 months, At this time the borders are not open. We don't even get US mail due to flights from Hawaii do not come to American Samoa. Please email us if you get this letter there are times we truly do miss home and yet we know that we know this is where God has assigned us.

Please continue to pray for us in all that God has before us. We believe for those things that are not seen and really bigger than where we are. Greater things are yet before us. Pray for souls to be saved, captives to be set free and for great discipleship. God is raising up a new generation of leaders. There is an older generation that experienced great things and many churches were established. We are praying that once again those things will be common place.
