What a wonderful time of ministry to Manumalo Baptist School and Manumalo Baptist Church. Jesus , balloons and shoes, Mindy even did a devotional for the teachers on a second day. Shoes to over 300 children !



Our time in Savaii was relaxing, new relationships and new doors open. Manumalo Baptist Church many saved that Sunday including a man William we had met on Upolu and here he was in Savaii, his mom had been praying for him for a long time. Another young lady just smiled when we met her again too!

We also have the opportunity to go out to the hospitals with Faith Angels and minister to patients in pediatrics and maternity. We are so blessed to share our time with this ministry. This month we even took balloons we went to one of the rural hospitals for the first time. The hospital beds pictures are for pediatric patient. Healthcare is different here you provide your own nurse aide; family takes that role and provide your own linen and meals.



We had one of our major outreaches at St Paul Academy it is a government school that just opened two months ago in the old prison. It is next the village of Tafaigata there were 368 students attending this elementary school. The needs of the community are great in this village they were displaced and moved here from the coast to inland. God has put this village on our hearts. We took 540 pair of shoes with came home with 79 pair. Many adults and teachers received shoes. You know the need is great when many came with no shoes at all. The principle told the children now you can come to school and have perfect attendance.

We would like to adopt the school at St Paul to help families in need. We have looked at what an outreach of food for each child would cost. To give a child a can of tuna and bag of noodles would be around \$1,200 US dollars. That is 8 cases of tuna and 30 cases of noodles. That will give 368 children food for the child and family. These families need our help, the COVID-19 has affected the economy, no tourist, no jobs.
