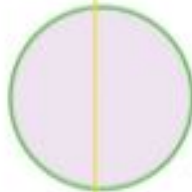
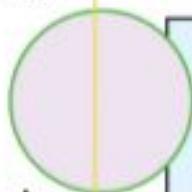

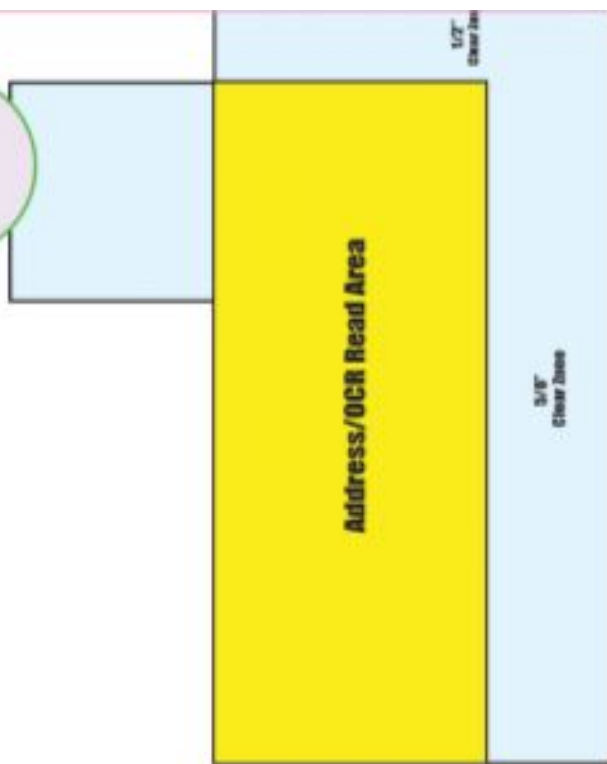

The leadership was overwhelmed they did not know we were coming with supplies. They told us what we brought would be 2 months worth and they did not have it in their budget



We had the opportunity to go with the local ministry. Samoa Victims Support Group. In the wake of measles epidemic 83 deaths most of them children. This group brought rice, noodles and clothing. We came alongside and gave shoes and balloons. We look forward to more ministry with SVSG.



We also were asked to join the Faith Angel Foundation to deliver gifts and blessing to those children with active measles in the hospital. To see Santa pray for the children was heartwarming. The staff were also happy to see us and enjoyed the balloons. We look forward to sharing some of our medical supplies with this ministry.



Our goal of giving 1000 pair of shoes to children is a blessing and opening doors. We are definitely going to be able to do that. We have now purchased a total of 648 pair of shoes. We have gone to the market, the park, to homes and now we have a school sheduled.

We have seen souls saved! Lives changed and so much more. Watch for more pictures as we minister to schools.
