Greetings to you!

The State of Emergency has relaxed flights are coming in one every two weeks from New Zealand with mandated 14-day quarantine. The economy here has suffered during this time, many families have lost jobs, and many have lost income from those overseas that would send funds. God has put on our heart to reach out to families during this time. We have provided some rice, noodles and tin fish (canned fish). We are planning an outreach in the village of Tafaigata in the future. There is a wonderful vision God has given for this place. Pray with us that God will have His way in this village. This was former Songi village that was forced to move.

We have continued to be active with various ministries here in the island. We have a weekly commitment on Tuesdays to minister the children at Samoa Victims Support Group (SVSG) Campus of Hope. We can't share pictures from here none are allowed unless they take them and publish. We are teaching the bible and loving on the children. These children are like foster children in the US.

Testimony from last week teaching in the one classroom. Four young girls were ministered to. The word was the 23rd Psalm the Lord is our Good Shepherd and keeps us safe and leads us in peace by the still waters. The tears that flowed in the room that day was so powerful in the healing that was taking place. We have four groups or classes that we have the opportunity to pour in the goodness of God. There are 12 to 15 toddlers they just want hugs and balloons, color and sit in your lap. The next group is 6 yr. old to 12 yr. old there are 18 in that classroom we do reading and various activities. Then the 13 to 18-year-old group we had donated bibles from Awakening Church of God and that is there English textbook to learn English! We read and discuss what the stories are. This week we read Joseph and talked about forgiveness. Then we reviewed the study that the teacher had for this week. Jesus in the garden. The next group are the children that SVSG brings in 3 days a week. The street vendors, they remembered us from 2018 and we have reconnected again teaching the word. We made sure to bring them shoes!

We have had our challenges and blessing this last month. We moved once again and this time we are praying to stay awhile. We love the new home and God knew it was time to "settle" it is a nice 3-bedroom home with room to have guest and some storage.

We have ministered in several churches this month and our host church. We minister at the hospital every two weeks on Saturday with Faith Angel Foundation. We are now both active with Mania the bible study group at local business. I am continuing to study for the exhorter exam.

Mindy has been asked to be one of the guest speakers at a Women's Conference in July. Keep us in prayer for this. She is also going to speak at a Women's Retreat in September.
