We want to say thank you! Because of your support we were able to donate and dedicate a 3000 liter water tank to the remote village of Samamea. What a beautiful time we had, not only did we dedicate the tank but we were also able to bring gifts, toys, clothes and food. We had some local businesses donate clothing and some of the food. A family donated toys. Everyone was surprised. They were only expecting us to dedicate the tank and we showed up with many blessings.

There are more children in the village than adults. Several large families were blessed! God is opening doors even in remote areas of Samoa. We hope to return to the village again and will depend on the weather. We are entering the rainy season here in Samoa and have to be careful traveling the road across the mountain. The drive is an hour and half from us and they call it the Psalm 23 road! The great news is the rainy season will fill the water tank rapidly and the families will have water without walking to the waterfall or stream. It has been really dry and finally received the rain that has been much needed.

The country is still in lockdown and the borders remain only open to those Samoans that are returning from overseas. No tourist and it has effected the economy here on the island.

We continue to minister at Aele Fou Primary School. We have 20 of the Action Bibles that the children share. We teach two 7th grade classes. We read the word then discuss the word and share Jesus. We then obtain vocabulary words and discuss definitions. The school has adopted us and the end of the school year is December 10th. The school year in Samoa is January to December. We are working with a local company and hoping to purchase more Bibles. We can't leave them at the school, we take them back and forth in suitcases.

What a joy to see the children engaged in the word of God. In a public school we have that open door and praise God for it. We are invited and attend functions at the the school. Pictures of teachers and students from Compulsory Education Days.

Ministry continues this month we did not have much scheduled then suddenly we did. Mindy and I ministered the word at Supernatural Fellowship and God moved and so many saved! Then we were asked to be part of the ministry team at Encounter a conference that was overwhelming!

At the encounter conference people repented of witchcraft, pornography, alcoholism and there were healings from incest. The altars were full after every session! The young people were running to the altar! There was no delay no pleading! God is moving and we are seeing answered prayer in so many lives.

We were invited to visit a new independent church in a village we had not been to. It is house church and Mindy preached a word and everyone in the church responded to the altar call for more of God! The pastor had tears and said the word was so on time and needed. That is our God! We give Him the praise and honor.

Our sponsoring church Great Harvest Church of God continues to grow. They have been fund raising and having BBQ on Saturdays. It has been fun to participate and give out free balloons with BBQ.

We also continue our weekly visits to the Campus of Hope. What a joy to interact with the children and also minister to the new children that come in. We spend time with the children letting them know how much Jesus loves them.



Thanksgiving Day here in Samoa is not a holiday but several restaurants have the meal. Mindy and I enjoyed a great meal. The best part of the day was going to the hospital in the Pediatric ward and ministering to children and parents. There were so many children there this week the wards were full. It is such a joy to see the smiles and know that our God heals and believing for miracles. The other part of Thanksgiving was surprising two families with food yesterday.
