January 2026

We began the year in prayer, attending a prayer conference at the Government Prayer House where the Prime Minister was the speaker. The following day, we were honored to be invited to a breakfast hosted by the ICEJ (International Christian Embassy of Jerusalem), whose representative from Fiji, Ms. Fine Ditoka joined us. We first connected with this organization in 2022 during our journey to Israel with Supernatural Fellowship. Jim had the privilege of joining local pastors in praying for the Prime Minister of Samoa, the Honorable La'aulialemalietoa Leuatea Polataivao Fosi Schmidt. He announced that Samoa would have an embassy in Jerusalem.

This month also brought some challenges concerning our children back home. Our great-granddaughter, Aspyn, has been seriously ill and has been hospitalized since January 1st. As of January 31st, she remains in the hospital; however, we are witnessing miraculous hand of God on her life.

It is remarkable to consider that, fifty years later, we find ourselves serving as missionaries on the island of Samoa. We are deeply grateful to God and continually give Him thanks.

Looking ahead, we are preparing for several initiatives before our planned visit to the United States from April to August. We anticipate sharing our itinerary next month as details are finalized. We will be attending the General Assembly in Orlando.
