We have been traveling and preaching and also ministering in other ways. Mindy was camp nurse for two weeks in Missouri and another week in Illinois and what a great time of ministry. Jim was logistics in Missouri and was Nurse Aide in Illinois. He became very skilled in application of bandaids .
